English: 4.0 credits

Math: 4.0 credits

Science: 3.0 credits

Social Studies: 3.0 credits

Physical Education: 1.0 credit

Foreign Language: 2.0 credits

Christian Studies: 2.5 credits

Fine Arts: 1.0 credit

Additional Electives: 4.5 credits

Total Required Credits: 25

*Beginning with the Class of 2021, 100 service hours will be required.

*Beginning with the Class of 2021, students will need a total of 7.0 credits between the Science and Social Studies subjects. Students may take 4.0 Science credits and 3.0 Social Studies credits, or 3.0 Science credits and 4.0 Social Studies credits.
