## Christmas Costume Info

Parents,

Before we know it, the Christmas program will be here! The students have been working on the Christmas music and are eagerly anticipating the production. The program will be held on Friday, Dec. 16, at 10:00am, in the Worship Center of First Baptist Church/Orlando.

You will find the costume assignments below and what you will need to provide to complete the costume. Students will wear **athletic-type shoes**. The school-supplied pieces will be kept at school and the students will dress in costume when they arrive on the morning of Dec. 16.

**K Prep/TK- Manger animals-** students will wear manger animal costumes (cows, donkeys, sheep, doves, or camels). Students should wear something under the vest (shirt, pants) that coordinates with their "animal". Please check with your teacher to find out which "animal" your child will be.

**Kindergarten- Snowmen(snowboys and snowgirls)-**Students will be provided with a "snowman" top. You will need to provide long, black pants and shoes.

**1<sup>st</sup> Grade – Snowflakes** – Students will be provided with a "snowflake" top. You will need to provide long, black pants and shoes.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – Christmas Trees** – Students will be provided with a "tree" top. You will need to provide long, brown or black pants and shoes.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Grade – Presents** – Students will be provided with an "presents" top. You will need to provide long, black pants and shoes.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade – Angels** – Students will be provided with an "angel" costume. Students will need to wear TFA clothing underneath (white shirt and khaki bottoms are suggested), and shoes. Teachers will provide garland halos.

**5<sup>th</sup> Grade – Shepherds** – Students will be provided with a "shepherd" costume. Students will need to wear TFA clothing underneath, and shoes. A rope-type belt would be a great addition to the costume, if you choose.
