- Homework in Math nightly
- Major emphasis on student independence, organization, personal responsibility and



1st Grade READINESS SKILLS

- Identify all upper and lower case alphabet names
- Mastery of lettersound association
- *Be able to blend sounds into words and read short vowel words and sentences (CVC Words)
- Know by sight the kindergarten sight word list
- Identify long vowel sounds
- Have a STAR Reading and Math Score 1.0+
- Number recognition up to 100
- Add and subtract numbers up to 10
- Count to 100 by ones, fives and tens


